Christianity Explored:

We are considering running a course again this year, but feel that for this to be
a worthwhile venture that those within the congregation who have previously
attended the course on a regular basis, that they seek to bring along someone
else who has not attended before on a regular basis. The reasoning is that this
time the course is being aimed primarily at those who have not previously
attended, whether within or outwith the congregation, seeing as a core group
in the congregation are already familiar with the course. We're not saying you
can't come if you've done the course before, but we would prefer that you try
to bring at least one other person along who hasn't completed the course
before.

To this end we have produced a form which you can fill in yourself if you
haven't done the course before and wish to do so, or if you have done it
before you can pass it on to neighbours and friends.

If we do not receive forms back from more than 2 or 3 who have not previously
attended then we may postpone the course until another time.
